1 [PROPOSED] JUDGMENT

2 On March 29, 2016 Petitioner California Policy Center, Inc.'s Petition for Writ of  
3 Mandate came for hearing before the Honorable Mary H. Strobel in Department 82 of the Los  
4 Angeles County Superior Court located at 111 N. Hill Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012. Chad D.  
5 Morgan, Esq. of the Law Office of Chad D. Morgan appeared for Petitioner California Policy  
6 Center, Inc. and Kenton E. Moore, Esq. of McCune & Harber, LLP appeared for Respondent  
7 City of Lynwood.

8 Upon consideration of the pleadings; the parties' briefs; declarations, exhibits, and other  
9 evidence filed in support of and opposition to the Petition; and after hearing the arguments of the  
10 parties, the Court (1) denied Petitioner's request for a Writ of Mandate ordering Respondent to  
11 produce additional records; (2) determined that Petitioner is the prevailing party based on the  
12 finding that Respondent was motivated by this lawsuit to produce public records prior to the  
13 hearing, which gave Petitioner the primary relief it sought; and (3) granted Petitioner's request  
14 for attorneys' fees finding that Petitioner is entitled to fees in the amount of \$22,262.50 based on  
15 a lodestar of 68.5 hours at a reasonable hourly rate of \$325 for attorneys Chad D. Morgan and  
16 Craig Alexander.
